Ramadan is observed by Muslims worldwide as a holy month of fasting (from dawn to sunset), prayer, reflection, and community.

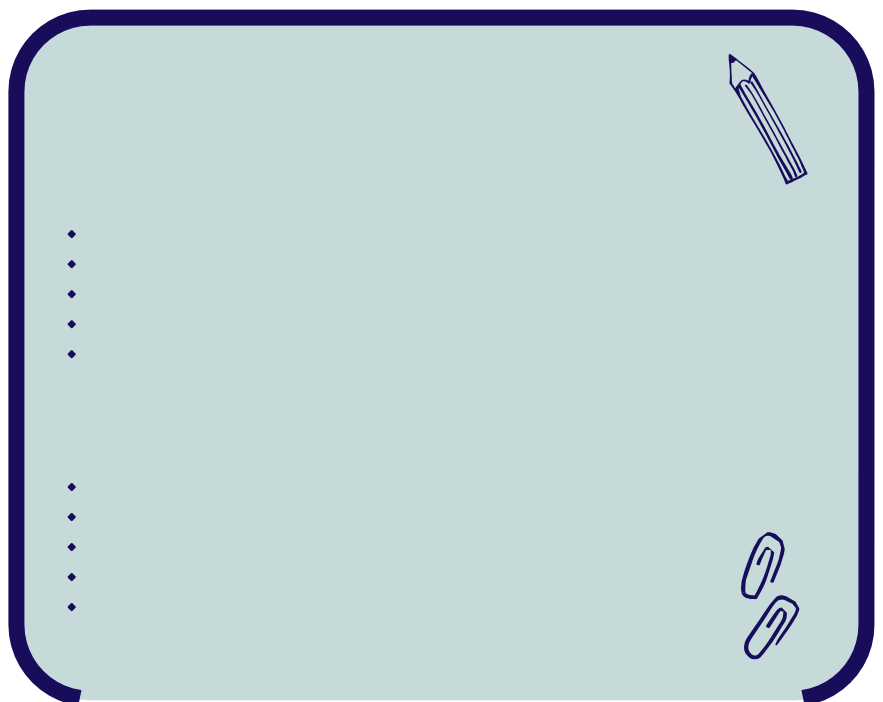
